2. My works pertain to four major fields:

French Language Syntax. After my PhD thesis *Syntaxe du français parlé*, a very innovative study in early 1980s, I focused my researches on the description of the French syntactic structures in connection with their discursive functions. In the two volumes published in 2000 and 2009, I proposed and developed two operational concepts for the solution of some issues in syntactic analysis, such as *constitutive complexity* and marked *complexity*.

Contrastive Analysis (French-Romanian). I published dozens of articles in the proceedings of international conferences of Romance Linguistics as well as in several linguistics journals: *Cercetări de lingvistică / Dacoromania*, *Revue roumaine de linguistique*, *Revue de linguistique romane*, *Studii și cercetări lingvistice*. My latest studies deal with the structure and discursive functions of the optative clause in French and Romanian. Two of these studies were published in a thematic issue of *Dacoromania*, that I initiated and coordinated in 2015-2016.

French Verb Grammar/ Fundamental Structures of French Language. My twenty years of researches in this field led to an ample dictionary of verbal constructions (688 p.) in which French verbs are treated in terms of *categories*, *inflection*, *paradigm*, *minimal structures* and *meanings*. Written in collaboration with Ioan Baciu and Dorina Roman, this book was edited by Dacia Publishing House in 2003. The reception of this book in France and Romania led to another *verbal constructions dictionary*, this time addressing to the French public and edited in collaboration with a CNRS researcher, Catherine Fuchs, at Ophrys Editions, Paris, in 2010.

Textual Linguistics and Discourse Analysis are the fields of my first and my latest works : *Temporalité, modalité et cohésion du discours* (1999), *Gen, text și discurs jurnalistic* and *Aspects de la problématique des genres dans le discours médiatique* (2011). The last two volumes are the result of my collaboration, as coordinator and contributor, with some scholars and PhD students. In 2018, I published *Pour une approche linguistique et pragmatique du texte littéraire. Seconde édition revue et augmentée*, which gathers ten linguistic studies on literary texts. Textual Linguistics and Discourse Analysis are the scientific directions followed by the PhD students who successfully defended PhD thesis between 2005 and 2017.
