Short description of the university programme * Please specify if this is a join/double degree programme (1250 characters)	<p>The Specialization of <i>Chinese Language and Literature</i> is aimed at supporting those who wish to study Chinese language, literature and culture at a Bachelor of Arts level in a specialized institution.</p> <p>The primary objective of the <i>Chinese Language and Literature</i> Specialization is to develop not only a linguistic competence which would allow the students the fluent use of the Chinese language, but also the formation of a cultural background which would aid them in their future endeavor of developing their Sinology studies. The courses are being taught both in Romanian and in Chinese, thus providing an adequate study and research environment. At the same time, because of the highly fruitful collaboration between the Department of Asian Languages and Literatures and the Confucius Institute within the university, students are given the opportunity to study the Chinese language, literature, and culture at different universities in China.</p> <p>In the context of the current economic dynamics and the increasing role China has to play in the international agenda, the <i>Chinese Language and Literature</i> specialization is oriented towards providing a wide array of specialized vocabularies, such as economic, political, legal, didactic, journalistic, and so on, which would allow graduates multiple opportunities of employment at the end of their studies.</p>
