Classes provide a comprehensive survey of the German culture, civilization, and literature, and in-depth practical and theoretical study of the German language. The range of courses offered by the Department of German Language and Literature includes courses of different types (compulsory lectures with accompanying seminars, elective lectures and practice seminars, i.e. practical courses) on the following subjects: Introduction to German literature and linguistics; Contemporary German Language; German Literature, Literary Epochs and Genres; German Language; German Literature, Literary Epochs and Genres; German Language; Tactice; Culture and Literature of the German Minority in Romania; DACH Regional Studies. The courses are supplemented by extra-curricular offers, e.g. study trips to Germany, workshops with German-speaking students, readings with contemporary German or Austrian authors, Christmas quizzes, summer schools, academic student conferences and awards, etc. Students are supervised by a year tutor (a teacher) and by students from higher years throughout the six semesters. Admission prerequisites: B1/B2-level of German in oral and written communication/baccalaureate Career opportunities: teacher; language trainer; translator/interpreter; book editor; journalist; researcher, literature and culture mediating professions (publisher's editor, culture officer), activities in libraries etc. Further academic training: the department offers 1 MA programs (German Studies in Europea Context), and the opportunity to apply for a PhD programme.
