Short description of the university programme * Please specify if this is a join/double degree programme (1250 characters)	<p>A Master's degree highly profiled on Romance literatures, cultures and languages, in accordance with the multilingual and multicultural policy of the European Council of Languages. The Master's programme is addressed to any candidate who possesses knowledge in a Romance foreign language (Italian, French, Spanish), regardless whether they own a Bachelor's degree in philology. During the admission procedures, the candidates are given the possibility to choose one of the teaching languages (Italian, French, Spanish) for the following two years of study; furthermore, each semester, they will have to attend a joint lecture taught in Romanian. The programme offers the possibility of: competence acquisition in several Romance languages (Italian, Spanish, Portuguese, French); studying in Romance languages and in Romanian; acquiring multilingual discursive practices, through inter-comprehension; competences and practices in literary translations and in humanistic sciences; the initiation in connected disciplines, such as: art, literary theory, mentalities, theory of argumentation etc.; practical stages in cultural institutions (for instance, the Centre for International Cooperation, the Italian Cultural Centre, the French Institute, publishing houses etc.). The Master's programme is meant to offer students openings, such as: translators of literary texts, text editors, experts in the dynamics of intercultural and inter-linguistic translations, within European and international organisations; professional activities providing positions in offices for international cooperation, in Italian, French, Spanish, Portuguese and Romanian cultural institutions, as well as in diplomatic and cultural representations, in national and international institutions; linguistic consultants in the editorial, theatre and show business fields etc.; teachers of foreign languages in the secondary, teachers within the academic field.</p> <p>Further academic training: the department offers the opportunity to apply for a PhD programme.</p>
