Short description of the university programme (1250 characters)	The European Master's in Translation Studies and Terminology operates within the <i>European Master's in Translation (EMT)</i> network, set up at the initiative of the Directorate General for Translation of the European Commission. Membership status is granted following an international evaluation of translation education programmes in EU member states. Our programme has been the sole Romanian representative programme since 2009, having had its membership reconfirmed for the third time in 2019. The languages of instruction are Romanian, English, French, German, and Spanish, with candidates selected according to the regulations applicable in the Romanian higher education system. The admission examination requires candidates to submit a translation project and a letter of intention. The curriculum focuses on translation theory, terminology, specialized translations, text editing and revision, terminological databases, documentation sources, subtitling and localization. The knowledge acquired in class is strengthened during the internships organized in cooperation with partners ranging from companies to public institutions. The programme is intended for those who target a career involving language professions and who want to develop their competencies in specialised translations, terminological construction and project management, to support such a career journey.

Admission requirements (description of pre-requisites for foreign students) (4000 characters)	Foreign students can enroll only if they exhibit a level of Romanian language performance. The Faculty can, on demand, offer supplementary Romanian language courses to complement the knowledge and skills foreign students may come with. It is important to note that Romanian is used as a pivot language with translations, including specialized translations in fields like law, medicine, scientific, technical, being proposed into and from Romanian. Foreign students without any Romanian language proficiency would find it difficult to engage with all activities of the Programme.
