Name of the university programme	Doctoral School of Hungarian Studies
Short description of the university programme	The Doctoral School of Hungarian Studies covers the field of Philology (language and literature, journalism, ethnology), for the Hungarian line of study at the Babeş-Bolyai University. Professors of the school teach at the Faculty of Letters (Department of Hungarian Literature, Department of Hungarian Language and General Linguistics, Department of Hungarian Ethnography and Anthropology). The doctoral school promotes interdisciplinary and intercultural dialogue and collaborates with scientific institutions in the field, and with other doctoral schools and scientific workshops. In the first year, students have 4 subjects of study (of a total number of 30 ECTS credits), and they collect data in their field of research. At the end of the first year, the students sit an exam to defend their research topic. In the second and third years, students submit a research report (paper).

The written exam: knowledge of specialised literature, presented by the doctorate advisor. The oral exam: presenting and defending the research topic and project.
